## C103-01 - Connecting your PC to the CMRR network

### When on Campus/CMRR building

Use the Wireless or Wired network.

In the office areas, use a blue network cable and plug into one of the hubs.

In the magnet rooms, only use the cables labeled for visitors.

### From Off Campus/Home

You need to install the Cisco Anyconnect client.

WINDOWS:

Download and install the client.

Start the VPN client, choose Departmental Pools, Anyconnect CMRR
