Standard Operating Procedure

C103-02 - Connecting PCs to CMRR server file shares

Connect to your server home directory

This will make a connection to your home directory on the servers.

Open Windows Explorer>Go to This PC>Click on the 3 dots in the upper right area of the Explorer Window>click on Map Network Drive

For an HST device, you will need to log in like this,

cmrr(CMRR ID)
(CMRR Password)

Here is an example of mapping your home folder and/or a Dicom folder.

[\\naxos2.cmrr.umn.edu](https://naxos2.cmrr.umn.edu)\dicom

If you are on a CMRR domain PC, you can simply use your CMRR ID without the **cmrr** in front of it.

At home, not on the VPN?

You must be on the CMRR VPN to connect to Windows file sharing from home.

Expired password?

Your password must be changed every year - if it has expired, you will not be able to connect. From a CMRR domain PC, you can visit <https://www.cmrr.umn.edu/access> choose my profile, and change CMRR server password.
